Notice to Exhibitors

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC or Ups 'N Downs Agility Club will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. You will be charged a \$25.00 handling fee, plus any bank service charges incurred for returned checks.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of any NADAC or Ups 'N Downs Agility Club representative, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no fees shall be refunded.

Class Changes

If you wish to move your dog up to a higher class prior to the trial, please notify the trial secretary no later than noon on Monday, May 29, 2017. Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday move-ups OK if made within 30 minutes of the conclusion of runs on Friday and Saturday.

Food

Breakfast items will be available Saturday and Sunday mornings. Hospitality will provide lunch Saturday and Sunday for all volunteers who work at least one class that day. Water will be available for volunteers each day.

Cancellations

Full refunds will be issued for cancellations prior to closing date. Cancellations after the closing date for bitches in season or injured dogs are subject to an administrative fee.

Check-in and Measurement

Gates will open at 12:00 PM on Friday and 6:30 AM on Saturday and Sunday. Please come help set up the field on Friday. Check in and measuring will be between 1:00 - 1:30 PM after general setup on Friday and 7:00 - 7:30 AM on Saturday and Sunday. The general briefing and judge's briefing will begin at 1:40 PM on Friday and 7:40 AM on Saturday and Sunday. The first dog on the line will be at 2:00 PM on Friday and 8:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday.

Awards

Placements ribbons will be awarded to at least fourth place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a pass/fail class.

- ❖ A purple qualifying ribbon shall be available for each qualifying round in each class.
- ❖ Please let us know in advance if you may receive a special award (NATCH) so we may celebrate the moment with you.

From CA-78 East: CA-78 becomes E Lincoln. Continue on E. Lincoln Ave, Turn right on El Norte Pkwy continuing to East Valley Pkwy. Turn left on East Valley Pkwy. Turn right at Lake Wohlford Rd, go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn into driveway.

From I-15 Southbound: Exit on Centre City Pkwy. Turn left at West El Norte Pkwy. Turn left at East Valley Pkwy. Turn right at Lake Wohlford Rd, go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn into driveway.

From I-15 Northbound: Exit on Via Rancho Pkwy which becomes Bear Valley Pkwy continuing until it ends at East Valley Pkwy. Turn right onto East Valley Pkwy. Turn right at Lake Wohlford Rd, go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn into driveway.

Alternate RV Route:
From any direction of approach, after turning north on E Valley Pkwy, continue driving past the summit until you reach Woods Valley Road (the first right turn). Woods Valley Road intersects with North Lake Wohlford Road (about 4 miles to a stop sign). At this intersection, turn south)

Categories and Jump Heights

Each class contains two categories, Skilled and Proficient. A dog may only be entered in ONE category per weekend. In the Skilled Category, dogs must jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. No dog may jump less than 4".

Measuring

Dogs which require measuring: Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"
Dogs which do not need to be measured: Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division, Dogs jumping 20", Dogs in the Skilled Category, Dogs with a permanent height card, Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List.

Non-Jumping Classes – Veteran or Disabled Handler

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

IMPORTANT:

- Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.
- NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups.
- The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.
- **LEVELS:** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

1.1 As used here NADAC or NADAC, LLC means North American Dog Agility Council, LLC and Ups 'N' Downs Agility Club, its members, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, show chairs, show committees, judges, and agents.

1.2 Exhibitors/owners agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, LLC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitors/owners certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitors/owners acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitors and owners assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitors/owners release NADAC, LLC (including NADAC, LLC and Ups 'N' Downs Agility Club and officers directors, employees, members, show chairs, show committee, agents, and exhibitors), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises.
